Other 'stuff'

Standardizing local rules-

1) Guests- We have decided that it might be fun to allow guests at our tournaments.

There should be some limits, and I'm proposing we start with the following:

- A) They will be limited to play once a year.
- B) They should have an established GHIN in good standing from a club.
- C) They should be of SIR genre. (What's that mean? They could be mistaken for a SIR-gray haired, forgetful, complain that their games not as good as it used to be--Etc.)
- D) They shouldn't look or play like a clubhouse pro!!

Repeating January Rules Memo

Standardizing local rules-

1) In an effort to speed up play We are modifying the 'lost ball on course' rule. After a normal search on the course, You may play your next ball from where you last saw your ball with a 1 stroke penalty. There is no distance penalty. If you hit it OB or lose it off the tee, the standard rule applies.

2) At a hazard, you may hit a provisional ball if you are not sure your ball cleared the hazard. This isn't allowed under USGA rules (rule 27), but it slows play greatly if you have to go search and then go back to the tee and hit again.

(We're not lawyers, and the writing of these instructions may show it, but I hope you can follow the spirit of these local rules. BR)
